Cape Mermaid Mystery by Carolyn Keene

While on vacation at the Mermaid Inn in New Jersey, Nancy, Bess, and George think that the inn may be haunted and set out to discover the truth.

The Case of the Beagle Burglar by Nancy Krulik

Jack suddenly has the ability to communicate with animals when he is bonked on the head by an acorn and uses this ability to solve the case of the missing homework.
