



Bravo Company Soldier, PFC Shane Reifert, Killed in Afghanistan

I received word we lost a Bravo Company soldier on Saturday, November 6th, when their base came under attack.

Private First Class (PFC) Shane Reifert of Cottrellville, Michigan, was 23 years old and had been with Bravo Company since December 2009. PFC Reifert is the first of our adopted soldiers to be killed in action since we adopted their unit in 2004. His fellow Bushmasters have taken his loss very hard.

In lieu of flowers his family has requested donations they can use to ship items to Shane's fellow soldiers in our 2nd platoon. The Burlingame Adopt-a-Unit supporters have sent a condolence card and monetary donation to honor their request.

Your support is even more important to these young men as they face the daily threat to themselves and the dangers that come their way in service to our country.
