


OverDrive eBook Download Instructions for Amazon Kindle

Burlingame Public Library



Equipment needed to ensure a successful download for checking out eBooks:

- A computer**
- An Amazon account**
- A Kindle**
- A library card**
- A USB cord, if Wi-Fi is unavailable**

OVERVIEW: In order to ensure a successful download, you will first need to register your Kindle device at www.amazon.com. Browse the Peninsula Library System's eBook catalog. Select and download eBook title(s) in the Kindle specific format. And finally, transfer or "sync" the title onto your eReader via a Wi-Fi connection or USB cord.

For those of you using the older generation Kindles, i.e. the Kindle keyboard, a USB cord will be needed in order to "sync" your device with your account and newly acquired eBook loan via a computer. However, if you are utilizing a Kindle Fire or Touch, you have the option of using the built-in Wi-Fi connection to load your eBook selection(s) directly.

Registering your Kindle device

1. Create/Log into your Amazon account
2. Under **Your Account**, select **Manage Your Kindle**
3. Select **Register a Kindle**
4. Enter your Kindle Serial Number

Checking out eBooks in Kindle format

Start your eBook browsing and selection process by visiting the Peninsula Library System's digital catalog at pls.lib.overdrive.com



Above Image: Patrons have the option of browsing our catalog by genre, media, age-level or featured titles. If you utilize the **Advanced Search** feature, you can hone your search even further by Format, Languages, Publishers, etc...

Under **All Formats**, in the **Advanced Search** window, condense your search to **Kindle Book** by pressing the drop-down menu. You can limit your choices further by checking the **Show only titles with copies available** box and click **Search**.

- **If you are looking for a particular title and it is currently unavailable, the option to Place a Hold is given.**

- You will then be prompted to select your PLS library. Once you select your library, please sign in with your library card number (no spaces required).

- Patrons may determine the duration of their digital loan lending period from 7 - 21 days. To do so, go to your account **Settings** and choose your digital loan lending period. Then click **Done**. (This will become your default digital loan lending period until you alter your account settings.)




- Your title has now been secured and transferred onto your library record. To begin downloading your title, click on the **Download** drop-down menu, select **Kindle Book** and click on **Confirm & Download**.


Note: Once you select a format, you may only be able to return the title via the software.



- Once the download is complete, you'll then be directed over to Amazon, where you can retrieve your loan by selecting the **Get library book** option. This window informs you when your title's loan period has expired and when your loan will automatically be removed from your device.



- If you have more than one device registered with Amazon, you will be asked to choose which one you want to utilize with the drop-down menu. After you have chosen click **Continue**.

- If for some reason Amazon cannot connect to your Kindle, it will tell you when that “Your public library book has been delivered to your Kindle. Your Kindle will download (the title) the next time it connects to Wi-Fi...”. This means that the next time you go to Burlingame Library or any place with Wi-Fi, it should show up when your device is synced. If you are unsure how to sync your Kindle, consult your device manual or see Amazon.com “help” for instructions on how to sync your device.

- Or you will also have the option to download the eBook to your computer and then transfer it to your Kindle via the **USB cable**. Click **Download now** to transfer this way.

- The eBook will be an .azm file and will be saved to its default location (usually in the Documents file under Downloads); the name of the file will be the-book-title.azm.



Select **Save File**, then click **OK**

This will save your Kindle Edition to the default downloads location.

To begin reading, first make sure your Kindle is connected to this computer via USB. Then, copy the downloaded file to the "documents" folder of your Kindle. It will appear on your Home screen.

- On your device, hit **Menu** and select the **Sync and Check for items** option in order to update your eReader's inventory.
- Once you find the file (be sure your Kindle is connected to your computer with the USB cord) move, copy, or "drag and drop" the file to the Kindle. Check you Kindle "Home page" to be sure it downloaded properly and begin enjoying your free eBook compliments of Burlingame Public Library and Peninsula Library System.

* NEW! OverDrive READ Feature *

● If you are using a Kindle device with Wi-Fi, you also have the option of viewing your title in your browser, as it is also available via **Read (in your browser)**. This new OverDrive feature is known as **OverDrive Read**. This enables you to view an eBook without the need to process a download.


