**The Alchemyst** by *Michael Scott*



**Here Lies Arthur** by *Philip Reeve*


After her home is destroyed, Gwyna is discovered in the forest by a bard who offers her protection if she will help young Arthur in his attempt to be King Arthur.

**The Merchant of Death** by *D.J. MacHale*

**Mister Monday** by *Garth Nix*
