WARNING

**Cooking oil and grease stick to the insides of your sewer pipes.
Over time, grease buildup can clog the entire sewer line.**



PREVENT SEWER OVERFLOWS

Keep Fats, Oils, and Grease Out of Your Drains

Pouring grease or used cooking oil into your sink is prohibited!

DON'T

Don't pour cooking oil, grease or greasy food down the drain.



Don't use hot water and soap to wash grease down the drain! It will cool and harden in the sewer line.



DO

Pour cooled grease into disposable containers or directly into the garbage if it's solidified.



Wipe away any residual grease or oil on dishes, pots or pans with a paper towel or rag before washing them.
