
Also known as (Also Known




The extraordinary adventures of Alfred Kropp (Alfred Kropp #1) by Richard Yancey


The merchant of death (Pendragon #1)

While on vacation from boarding school, young James Bond tries to solve the mystery of a missing boy and stumbles onto a sinister operation at the mansion of a madman.




Spy high: mission one (Spy High #1) by A.J. Butcher




Stormbreaker (Alex Rider #1) by Anthony Horowitz
