The public is invited to attend the second community meeting for the Carolan Avenue “Complete Streets” Project. As explained in the first public meeting, this project will involve modify Carolan Avenue between Broadway and Oak Grove Avenue by making changing the four lane configuration to a two lane road with designated bike lanes and a center turn lane. As part of this project, curb bulb outs, pedestrian safety enhancements, landscaping, and storm water treatment facilities will be added in certain locations.

This second community meeting will present information and preliminary plans on several design alternatives which incorporate desired elements brought forth at the previous public meeting. These design elements include various versions of dedicated bike lanes, on-street vehicle parking configurations, pedestrian improvements, and vehicle lane configurations.

Please join City representatives and project team members to learn about the project and give your feedback on design options. There will be an interactive question and answer period with the project team immediately following the presentation.
