Amy wakes up on a space ship after being cryogenically frozen and learns that someone might have tried to kill her.




### The adoration of Jenna Fox by Mary E. Pearson

Em and Finn must travel back in time to kill the person responsible for creating a time machine that destroys the world.




### Cinder by Marissa Meyer




### Maximum Ride- the Angel experiment by James Patterson


### Never let me go by Kazuo Ishiguro

### Noggin by John Corey Whaley

### Ship breaker by Paolo Bacigalupi

### Skinned by Robin Wasserman

### The Supernaturalist by Eoin Colfer

In this science-fiction thriller, fourteen-year-old Cosmo escapes from a work-camp orphanage and begins to use his ability to see supernatural parasites in hopes of saving his city. (also a graphic novel)

### Things not seen by Andrew Clements

When fifteen-year-old Bobby wakes up and finds that he is invisible, he and his parents and a new friend, try to find out what caused his condition and how to reverse it.



### Uglies by Scott Westerfeld

In Tally's world, everyone receives cosmetic surgery at age sixteen to make them "pretty." Tally joins a group who is rebelling against this and must decide if turning pretty is the right choice for her. (Uglies series, bk.1)

### Unwind by Neil Shusterman

Risa, Conner, and Lev live in a strange society that "unwinds" unwanted teens prior to their eighteenth birthday. The three go on a long journey trying to survive until they turn eighteen. (Unwind Dystology series, bk.1)
