If we kiss by Rachel Vail


A high school freshman struggles with her feelings for Kevin, her best friend's boyfriend, after he kisses her.

Julia has always thought Mark was her "meant to be". During a school trip to London, Julia begins to have second thoughts.


My life next door by Huntley Fitzpatrick

Scrambled eggs at midnight



Sweethearts by Sara Zarr


