

While visiting an archeological dig near her home in Texas, eleven-year-old Esther slips into another time period- the Pleistocene era- where she meets a group of mammoth hunters.




Angel of the battlefield by *Ann Hood*


Archer's quest by *Linda Sue Park*

When the medieval archer and king, Chu-mong, appears in Kevin's room, Kevin searches for clues that will help send the king back to his time period in ancient Korea.




Beswitched by *Kate Saunders*

While traveling to her new boarding school, Flora is transported to 1935, where she has swapped places with another girl. How will she survive without her iPod? How will she find her way back to her own time period?




The book of time by *Guillaume Prevost*

In this zany story, a father makes what he thinks will be a quick run to the store for some milk. Instead, he returns, after an extended time, recounting a story of alien abduction, pirates, a stegosaurus professor, time travel, and many great adventures.



Found by *Margaret Peterson Haddix*

Jonah and his friend Chip, both of whom are adopted, begin receiving mysterious letters that tell them they are "one of the missing." They, along with Jonah's sister Kate, uncover a mystery involving time travel and a mysterious airplane full of babies, but no adults, that appears out of nowhere. (The Missing series)



The glass puzzle by *Christine Brodien-Jones*

In this adventure story, cousins Zoe and Ian find a mysterious glass puzzle while vacationing in Wales with their grandpa. When they put the puzzle together, they open a portal into a mysterious realm.



Honus and me: a baseball card adventure by *Dan Gutman*

When twelve-year-old Joe finds a magical baseball card of Honus Wagner, he is transported back in time to the 1909 World Series. (Baseball Card Adventures series)



King of shadows by *Susan Cooper*

As Nat prepares to perform as Puck in A Midsummer Night's Dream at the modern day Globe Theatre, he is overcome with a high fever and suddenly transported back to 1599 where he meets William Shakespeare.



The last musketeer by *Stuart Gibbs*

While traveling through time to rescue his missing parents, fourteen-year-old Greg meets the future Three Musketeers. (The Last Musketeer series)



A wrinkle in time by *Madeleine L'Engle*

Meg Murray, her younger brother and her friend Calvin travel through space and time to rescue her father, who has slipped through a "tesseract" - a wrinkle in time.



The magic half by *Annie Barrows*

Eleven-year old Miri is the only single child in a family with two sets of twins. Her family moves into an old Victorian farmhouse, and she finds herself traveling back in time to 1935, where she meets a young girl named Molly. Miri tries to figure out a plan to bring Molly back with her. This is a book full of surprises.



A mutiny in time by *James Dashner*

In this first book in the Infinity Ring series, history is broken and Dak, Sera and Riq must travel back through time to set things right and rescue Dak's missing parents. (Infinity Ring series)



Time snatchers by *Richard Ungar*

Orphaned Caleb travels through time to steal priceless historical artifacts for his malicious guardian who sells them to the highest bidder.



Walking with the dead by *L. M. Falcone*

Alex's father brings home an ancient mummy from his work at the Oddities Museum, and many weird things begin to happen, especially when the 2,000-year-old corpse wakes up!



The Wells Bequest by *Polly Shulman*

In this humorous adventure, Leo uses H.G. Wells' time machine to go back in time to 1895 to meet Nikola Tesla.
